Description of the Program

The Master in Education major in Measurement and Evaluation is a 14-month non-thesis program which starts August 2017 and ends October 2019. Combining the study of research design, testing and assessment, and evaluation, this program is designed to prepare students for research and academic careers in education, social sciences, and human services.

Coverage of the Scholarship

All successful applicants will receive full scholarship which provides tuition, basic, and miscellaneous fees for the entire duration of the program. The scholarship will not cover other costs such as instructional materials and living and travel expenses.

Scholarship Eligibility and Requirements

Selection of successful candidates must will be based on the following:

1. Must be a Filipino citizen
2. Evaluation of credentials
3. Examination results
4. Interview
