About the Test

The ELCOM is a paper-and-pencil test composed of multiple choice items in the following content areas:

Quantitative	30
Verbal Filipino	30
Science	30
Nonverbal Reasoning	30
TOTAL NO. OF ITEMS	150
DURATION	2 HOURS and 40 MINUTES

Test Scores

The ELCOM yields eleven content area scores, five subtest scores and two total scores – Elementary Level Competency (ELC) and General Scholastic Aptitude (GSA). The two total scores are reported in standard scores and percentile ranks. ELC is the composite score based on the eleven content area scores: *Vocabulary, Grammar and Usage, Reading Comprehension, Fundamental Operations, Problem Solving, Talasalitaan, Pagsulat, Pagbasa, General/ Earth Science, Biology, and Chemistry/ Physics*. GSA is the composite score based on the five subtests. The ELC and GSA scores are indicators of scholastic potential for high school.

Test Report Forms

1. **Examinee Report Form (ERF)** is an individual report form. It presents the examinee's scores on the content areas, subtests, ELC and GSA. This report is for the student.
2. **Masterlist of Test Results (MTR)** is a list of all examinees' test scores. Total number of examinees, the group's mean and standard deviation, and the average difficulty level (ADL) of the content areas are shown. This report is given to the school.
3. **Institutional Performance Profile (IPP)** presents the overall profile of students' performance. It shows a table of descriptive statistics and graph of overall score by quality index. This report is given to the school upon request.
