1. Reports students' knowledge on words, numbers, series of figures, and details.
2. Guides admission personnel/guidance counselors in placing students to different programs in the school.
3. Complements other information for admission to higher academic level.

About the Test

The GLT is a two-part test. The first part is a paper-and-pencil test that consists of multiple-choice items. The second part is an essay test that the school may choose to administer.

Test Scores

The GLT provides scores for the subtests and for the whole test. The scores are reported as standard scores. The General Aptitude Score (GAS) is the score based on the three subtests: Verbal, Quantitative, and Inductive Reasoning. The scores are presented as standard scores to allow comparison of the scores across subtests and among examinees.

Test Report Forms

1. **Examinee Report Form (ERF)** is an individual report form. It presents the examinee's subtest and GAS scores. This report is for the student.
2. **Masterlist of Test Results (MTR)** is a list of all examinees' test scores. Total number of examinees and mean and SD are presented in the MTR. This report is given to the school.
3. **Institutional Performance Profile (IPP)** presents an assessment of overall performance of the examinees on the entire test and on the subtests. This report is given to the schools upon request.



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
