Dr. Grace H. Aguiling-Dalisay is an Educator, a Leader in Volunteerism and a Registered Psychologist. She served as the President of the Pambansang Samahan sa Sikolohiyang Pilipino and Executive Secretary of the Psychological Association of the Philippines.

Her educational leadership includes senior executive roles in various Higher Education Institutions. She was the chair of Tri-College PhD Philippine Studies Executive Council, Chair of the Department of Psychology, College of Social Sciences and Philosophy and Dean of College of Social Sciences and Philosophy of UP Diliman. She also served as the Vice-President for Academic Affairs of Miriam College, President of Republican College and Board Member of the Philippine Association of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities (PAPSCU).

She is an Adjunct Professor of the Faculty of Education, UP Open University and Retired Full Professor of Developmental Psychology of UP Diliman, with specialization in Indigenous Psychologies and the Development of Volunteering and Civic Engagement.
